2026 GOLF COURSE RULES

1. Members must register and pay greens fee for their guests prior to playing and accompany them at all times. Check By Laws for definition of guest.
2. Guest fees are \$15.00 for 9 holes and \$20.00 for all day. Cart fees are \$10.00 per person in a cart and \$20 per person for 18 holes.
3. Soft spikes or soft-soled shoes mandatory.
4. Proper attire must be worn by both sexes at all times. Men must wear shirts with sleeves. Women may wear sleeveless tops or blouses. At no time will cut away tank tops, bathing suits or tube tops be allowed on the golf course.
5. The Golf Management Council must approve all course events.
6. No course events will be scheduled on weekends except club functions.
7. A rental fee will be charged and the course will be closed for all non-club functions. A non-club function is any organized outing sponsored by a company, organization or charity to establish goodwill, earn a profit or promote a cause. These outings must be approved in advance by the GMC.
 - A. Non-club golf activities may be limited to two events per month.
 - B. Club sponsored activities have first priority.
 - C. Non-club activities will be charged a fee of \$500.00 to close the course
For a nine hole event from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
 - D. Non-club activities will be charged a fee of \$1,100.00 to close the course
from 11:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.
 - E. Non-club activities will be charged a fee of \$1,200.00 to close the course
for any longer period of time.
 - F. Non-club activities **must** vacate the course no later than 5:30 p.m.
8. There will be a "Course Activity" sign at the number 1 tee and a calendar posted in the keg room to keep everyone informed of all events.

OVER

9. All players are requested to begin play on hole #1. The #1 tee box is closed on Mondays after 5:00 p.m. (Ladies' League) and Thursdays from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. (Men's League).
10. Only groups of five or less will be allowed. This rule will be strictly enforced.
11. Persons under 16 years of age are not permitted to operate riding carts.
12. Children under 14 years of age are not permitted to play golf on weekends and Holidays or after 4:00 p.m. on weekdays, unless accompanied by an adult. Parents are reminded to not let children "wander" away from them on the course.
13. Slower players must let faster players through.
14. All course signs MUST be obeyed and cart paths used.
15. Replace divots and repair ball marks on greens. Let's get in the habit of fixing yours and one more.
16. Rake sand traps
17. Do not litter. Please use trash containers provided.
18. All members are responsible for enforcing these rules. Report any violations to the Golf Management Council.
19. Violators of these rules face possible disciplinary action by the Board of Directors.
